Note:

A. In districts where there are less than 500 applicants, the candidates will be shifted to the second option exercised. In exam districts exceeding the maximum capacity of applicants allotted in case of both options exercised, the Board has the right to select the exam district independently irrespective of options exercised.

5. Computer Proficiency Test (CPT)

- a. For all clerical and allied post, CPT will be a mandatory qualifying criteria. Hence, marks secured in the CPT will not be added to the final total marks.
- b. The Board will hold Computer Proficiency Test (CPT), comprising of basic working skills/knowledge of Computer for candidates shortlisted on the basis of their score in the written examination. The qualifying benchmark for the CPT shall be 30% of the total marks allocated for CPT.

^{*}Marks awarded to a candidate appearing in the Personal Interview shall not be less than 40% of the total marks allotted for Interview and generally not more than 80% of the total marks allotted for Interview.

NOTE:

- 1. The upper age limit is relaxable by:
 - (a) 5 (five) years for candidates belonging to SC/ST.
 - (b) Age concession for serving Government employees will be allowed, the equal number of years they are in service subject to a maximum of 5(five) years.
 - (c) Upper Age relaxation will be admissible for a period of two years w.e.f 22nd April 2021 as per Government OM NO.AR-5/ASSO/98(Vol-I) Dated 28-02-2022.

- 3. 100% of the vacancies are reserved for Indigenous Inhabitant of the State of Nagaland.
- 4. Candidates shall be given an opportunity for exercising preference of posts and department before the conduct of Viva voce.
- 5. Implementation of reservation for Backward Tribes in the State shall be in accordance with the Notification issued vide NO.RCBT 5/87(pt-II) dated14-04-2011, 15-06-2012 & 04.09.2015.
- 6. Reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBDs), wherever applicable as sanctioned by the user department in accordance with the Government Notification NO.AR-3/Gen-9/97 dated 13th August 2020. And as per Rights of Persons with disabilities Act, 2016 ,Section 2 (r), Person with Benchmark Disability means a person with not less than Forty percent (40%) of a specified disability.

7. Terms & conditions.

- i. Only those candidates who possess the requisite qualification acquired from recognized university/institution at the time of applying/ or before the close of registration will be eligible to apply for the post(s).
- *ii.* Candidates must produce attested/self-attested photocopies of the following documents/materials to the Board as and when called for:
- a) HSLC/Matriculation/Equivalent Admit Card for proof of Date of Birth. No other Certificate will be accepted for age proof.
- b) Indigenous Inhabitant Certificate, Scheduled Tribe Certificate, Backward Tribe Certificates as relevant and applicable (new FORMAT).
- c) For Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBDs), certificate from Competent Medical Authority is required.
- d) Proof of Educational Qualifications: Mark Sheet/transcript & Pass Certificates/Provisional Pass certificates from matriculation onwards till requisite qualification. If for any reason, pass certificates/provisional pass certificates are not issued by the Board/Institute/University, a letter/certificate to that effect from the Board/Institute/University must be submitted.
- e) No Objection Certificate from the Head of Department/Public Undertaking to be furnished in case the applicant is an employee of the Government or Public Undertaking. The signing Authority shall be the Head of the Department only.
- f) All relevant documents/certificates to be submitted should have been issued by the concerned authority/institution/board/university on or before the last date of submission of application form.
- g) All original documents are also to be produced as and when called for and also during interview without which candidates will not be allowed to appear the interview.
- 8. Indigenous Inhabitant Certificate, Scheduled Tribe & Backward Tribe Certificates should be signed only by District Authority not below the rank of Additional Deputy Commissioner.

Information is given in advance that henceforth Schedule Tribe/ Indigenous Inhabitant Certificate and Backward Tribe Certificate are to be submitted to the

Board <u>as per the new revised Government Format at the time of document verification.</u> Therefore, candidates are informed to keep the documents ready in advance.

- 10. In case it is detected at any stage of recruitment that a candidate does not fulfil the eligibility norms and/or that he/she has furnished incorrect/false information or has suppressed any material fact(s), his/her candidature shall stand cancelled.
- 11. The Board will not entertain any relaxation in the educational qualification criteria from the Departments after the close of the registration.
- 12. The decision of the Board in all matters regarding eligibility, conduct of examination, other tests and selection would be final and binding on all candidates. No representation or correspondence shall be entertained by the Board in this regard.
- 13. Application forms <u>will not</u> be issued from the office of the Nagaland Staff Selection Board (NSSB). Only online application is available. Candidates can submit the online application through http://http://nssb.nagaland.gov.in
- 14. **One Time Registration** (OTR) is mandatory. Candidates are to first register themselves in the OTR and further proceed for registration of online submission of forms.
- 15. The Online application will be available from 14th August 2023 (12:00 Noon) till 4:00 PM of 8th September 2023
- 16. Examination Fee of **Rs 300/- (Rupees Three Hundred)** only will be charged for all Clerical and Allied Services Examination 2023. PwBDs candidates are exempted from payment of examination fee.
- 17. For candidates who are Government employees, "NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE" signed by the Head of Department (HoD) only should be uploaded while submitting online application. NOC format may be downloaded from the Board's website http://http://nssb.nagaland.gov.in. No other format will be accepted.
